



Levee en Masse - May 2009

A 6mm Napoleonic Volley & Bayonet Event

“Levee en Masse” is a 6mm Volley & Bayonet gaming event gaming hosted by the [Christchurch Wargames Club](#), Woolston Club, Christchurch on Sunday the 17th May 2009.

Registration is free and open to members of the Christchurch Wargames Club and guests by arrangement. To assist in organisation players are required to pre-register by emailing keith@mcnelly.co.nz

“Levee en Masse” will use the “Volley & Bayonet: Road to Glory” rules and the Half Scale basing standard.

Armies:

Some loan armies may be available. Contact the organiser if you can assist in this area or require a loan army.

Armies are limited to a nominal value of 3000 points. Permitted lists are those defined in the Napoleonic Wars section of the rules. Players are encouraged to bring multiple lists or armies to ensure historical matchups.

Basing & General Guidelines:

Tables will measure 1200mm x 900mm. Terrain will be pre-fixed. Players are requested to bring their own terrain.

All models must accurately represent the items they depict. All models must be painted and based according to the Volley & Bayonet rules modified to the half scale basing standard. These standards, along with minor local guidelines can be found at:
