

TO&E Amendments 1944

Revision Date: 16th January 2007 (Draft)

The following amendments to the Spearhead TO&E apply.

All troops defined here are costed as regular or better unless noted otherwise.

German:

To represent late war German Kampfgrups German battalions may be purchased with cross-attachments pre-calculated. For example a 1944 Panzer battalion may have two Panzer companies and one Panzer Grenadier companies. The Panzer Grenadiers can be with or without transport.

To represent the increasing failure to comply with full TO&E 1944 & 1945 support elements as defined in the TO&E may be downgraded by using a cheaper support weapon, as defined by the points system, of a similar role. Examples include, an Ostwind may be represented by a self-propelled or towed 20mm or 37mm AA weapon, a Pak40 anti-tank gun may be replaced by a Pak 38 or a fighting battalion's reconnaissance tank may be replaced by a lighter reconnaissance vehicle, such as a motorcycle stand.

All Divisions:

Additional support units may include:

Up to one Werfer Battalion, which must be off table, with:
2 to 3 Nebelwerfers with an on table FAO.

Panzer, Panzer Grenadier and Infantry Divisions:

Additional support units may include:

Up to one Company of Heavy Armour selected from one of the following:
1 to 2 Veteran Tiger I or Tiger II,
1 to 2 JagdPanthers,
1 Elefant.

Existing troops may be replaced with:

Panzer Grenadier or Panzer divisions may completely replace any divisional anti-tank battalion's anti-tank gun company with the following. Self-propelled companies must replace self-propelled and towed with towed. If these options are selected the respective company must me entirely of the one weapon type.
2 to 3 Jagpanzer IV or Hetzers,
2 to 3 PAK 43 towed 88mm guns.

Volks Grenadier Divisions:

May replace a divisional anti-tank battalion anti-tank gun company with a single company consisting of:
2 to 3 Hetzers.

German Fallschirmjager Divisions:

May replace a divisional towed anti-tank battalion company with a single company selected from one of the following:
1 to 2 Marders,
1 to 2 Semovente M40-42 (Italian theatre only).

British:

All Divisions:

Additional support units may include:

Up to two artillery batteries, each counting as a "battalion", which must be off-table. Each consisting of:
2 5.5" guns with trucks, no FAO

Infantry Divisions:

Up to one Tank or Armoured Regiment, or part, drawn from a Tank or Armoured Brigade may be used to support an infantry division. The armour may fight as a fighting battalion or be allocated as support troops.

Russian:

Russian "Corps" count as divisions within the Spearhead rules.

Small Russian divisional support battalions, which do not comprise separate companies such as the 1944 Tank Corps Tank Destroyer Regiment of four SU-85s, count as one company for attachment purposes. They may also be fielded as Small Battalions as described in section 3.0 of the Scenario Generation System. See also the clarifications file for defining command stands in small Russian battalions.

All Divisions:

Additional support units may include:

Up to two Artillery battalions, which must be off-table, with:
3 122/22 howitzer and trucks, no FAO
Up to one Artillery battalion, which must be off-table, with:
3 152/29 howitzer and trucks, no FAO or
2 BM-13 Katyushas, no FAO.

Infantry Divisions:

Additional support units may include:

Up to one Breakthrough Regiment with:

1 HQ Stand in car or truck

4 or 6 Heavy Tank stands

3 SMG stands (ride on tanks)

Heavy tanks are either KV-1, KV-85, IS-2, SU-122, SU-152, ISU-122 or ISU-152 and must be of one type.

American:

All Divisions:

Additional support units may include:

Up to one artillery battalion, which must be off-table consisting of :

3 155/20mm howitzer with trucks, no FAO

American Airborne Divisions:

Additional support units may include:

Armoured support from Corps assets selected from one of the following:

3 Sherman,

3 M10 and 1 M20 armoured car.

Existing troops may be replaced with:

All 37mm ATGs replaced with 57mm ATGs in any unit.

American Armoured Divisions:

Up to one artillery battalion, which must be off-table, selected from one of the following:

3 155/20mm howitzer with trucks, with an on table FAO.

3 105/25mm howitzer with trucks, with an on table FAO.
