Breakout from Suvla Bay: British Order of Battle

Intelligence Briefing: 8 August 1915

It is 8 August 1915. The British 10th and 12th Infantry Divisions (New Army divisions formed in the past 8 months, newly arrived from the United Kingdom, and untried in battle) have landed over the past one and a half days. While the men have got ashore, the divisional artillery still languishes aboard ship, and there is a water shortage, keenly felt by the men. In addition you have been landed with little or nothing in the way of maps of the terrain that you face. Your forces have suffered from occasional sniping and harassing artillery fire throughout the previous day and night, after having captured the two hills Lala Baba and Hill 10 close to the landing beaches.

It seems that there are light Turkish forces to your front, but that there seems to be little in the way of organised opposition between you and your objectives: the high ground that surrounds the landing beaches, and a route across the peninsular. Finally you may be able to force the Turkish forces off the Gallipoli Peninsular, the navy will be able to force the narrows, and Istanbul is there for the taking.
