



Battle of the Silver Helmets Halen, 12 August 1914

Special Rules

1. Artillery is limited to a maximum of 10 artillery fire missions

2. The River Gette is not fordable.
3. Advanced morale rule is available to Belgian forces.
4. The Belgian commander may choose whether to allow infantry reinforcements to arrive on-table. If the option is selected, then the reinforcements will be available on turn 10. The reinforcements may enter the table from any table side that is south of the River Gette. The Belgian infantry command HQ stand operates independently of the Belgian cavalry divisional command stand. The Belgian commander must write down before the start of the game whether the reinforcements will be used, and in accordance with Spearhead rules, must mark on a map the entry point for those reinforcements. This information will not be available to the German commander.
5. The Belgian commander may use up to five 6" lengths of level 1 entrenchments. Any entrenchments placed within 12 " of Velpen village will have hedges to the front, which provide spotting cover.
6. The Belgian commander may place up to 7 lengths of hedge anywhere south of the River Gette. Each hedge may be up to a maximum of 6" in length. These hedges provide spotting cover.

Victory Conditions (Belgian)

1. If the Belgian commander chooses to bring on the infantry reinforcements, then no German cavalry stands may be left south of the River Gette at the end of the game.

OR

2. If the Belgian commander chooses NOT to bring on the infantry reinforcements, then the Belgian forces must control the highest terrain contour of the ridge south of Halen. No German forces may be present on the ridge.
