### How to Apply

Read the information on this page carefully and share it with your Rover friends. Complete this Application Form. Give your completed Application Form together with your deposit of \$50.00 to the Medieval Moot address listed in 10 Steps to Medieval Moot. (International applicants send to your National Scout office) As soon as possible but NO LATER than 31 January 2005. It is essential you get money in on due dates.

#### Rover Scouts:

- (i) must be a member of a Crew or squire as at 24 March 2005 and be prepared to accept the rules of the Moot.
  - (ii) must have approval of their Crew Executive, and District Commissioner.
- Fill in all pages of this Application Form. All applicants must be recommended by their Group Leader, District Commissioner, Area Commissioner, or Branch Director, as appropriate.

**Applications are only accepted as hard copy.** Applications may be printed out from the website, and filled in, but need to be posted to the Medieval Moot postal address. Emailed applications will not be accepted. Please let us know if you would like an automatic payment form posted to you.

### The Fee

The Moot fee is set at \$299.00NZD including GST. This fee includes all meals and most programme activities during the event (except tour fees if any), administration etc. but not travel to and from the Moot City. Your Moot travel Co-ordinator will advise you of the overall cost including travel. A deposit of \$50.00 must accompany your application when you send to Medieval Moot. This must be done before 31 January 2005. The balance of your fee including tour costs (prices listed under 'tour list' overleaf), must be paid to Medieval Moot by 14 March 2005. The Moot fee for Staff is \$250.00 including GST. A deposit of \$50.00 is required with each application. The balance of the fee must be paid by 14 March 2005. All cheques to be made out to: **Scouting New Zealand Rover Moot.**

### Privacy Act

In compliance with the Privacy Act 1993 the following is brought to your attention:

- (a) This application form collects personal information about you.
- (b) The information is collected –
  - i. to decide whether you will be permitted to attend the Medieval Moot
  - ii. to make arrangements for your participation and welfare should you be permitted to attend.
- (c) The information is being collected for The Scout Association of New Zealand and will be used by the organisers and managers of the 63rd New Zealand Moot and will form part of the Association's membership records and is available to your Group, District and Area.
- (d) The information (other than medical information) will be held and stored electronically by The Scout Association of New Zealand, and which will be destroyed after the event.
- (e) You have rights of access to, and correction of, this information subject to the provisions of the Privacy Act 1993.
- (f) The information you provide on the Medical Information form is for use by those responsible for your welfare at the 63rd New Zealand Moot and access to it will be restricted accordingly. It will not be stored electronically and will be destroyed after the Moot.

### Important Notes for All Applicants

If your application is accepted **your deposit of \$50.00 is not refundable**, but may be transferred to a new applicant. In the event of accident or sickness preventing you from attending, the amount of the Moot Fee you have paid will be refunded in full upon receipt of a medical certificate. The Moot fee is based on an anticipated attendance, which has been budgeted for. Should applications fall short of this number or the cost of services or supplies escalate, to the extent that a loss may occur, the Moot Organising Committee shall have the right to adjust the fee. In this event, a participant may withdraw and receive a refund - less the initial deposit, as described above. This will be made by 28 February 2005.

### Eligibility

#### Rovers

You must be an invested Rover. Ages 18-26

#### Squires

You must be an official Squire to your crew. Ages 18-26

#### Associate Rover

You must be an invested Associate Rover aged 26-34 years.

#### International Rover

You must have approval from your National Scout Office.

#### Young Leaders:

- (i) Young Leaders must be between the ages of 18-26 years as at the opening day of the Moot and hold a warrant.
- (ii) All Young Leaders must have the approval of the Group Leader, District Commissioner or Area Commissioner.

#### Moot Staff

A small number of adults are needed to serve as staff members. Adults holding warrants in any section of the Movement as well as Associate Rovers are welcome.

Please complete the application form and include details of your skills that may be of use during the Moot.

### The Application

All those who wish to attend the Moot, whether or not they are members of the Scout Movement, MUST complete a formal application.
